## What to do After a Crash:

- Get to Safety! Make sure you are out of the way of moving traffic and that you are visible.
  Call 911! You may later regret not reporting the crash. Insist that a police report is made.
- · Note the Officer's name, Precinct and Report Number.
- Gather as much information as you can. If you physically can't, have someone do it for you.
- Open and use our App. It will help you collect critical crash information.
- Obtain the name of the Driver, Vehicle Owner, License Plate Number, Make, Model and Color of the vehicle.
- Obtain the vehicle's insurance information and the insurance policy number.
- If the accident involves a street defect, take a photo of it. These conditions can change quickly.
- Get the names of all witnesses, their phone numbers and addresses.
- Preserve all evidence. Don't discard your bike, helmet or other evidence.
- · Don't admit fault or give a statement to anyone.
- When you have gathered all the information and you feel ready to talk, call or e-mail us to discuss your legal rights and options.
